NOMINATION GUIDELINES

PURPOSE:

1. To recognize one REALTOR® member of the Ada County Association of REALTORS® who exhibits leadership and the knowledge of the REALTOR® Code of Ethics, Arbitration and/or professional standards and who is known to share such information with other real estate professionals.
2. To demonstrate to the general public the personal and professional accomplishments by REALTORS®.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION PROCESS:

1. Nominations may be submitted by individual REALTOR® members, firms, broker/managers, or association leadership, and does not exclude the member's own office. Multiple nominations will be considered as one submission.
2. The nominee must be an ACAR primary member for the year 2011, in good standing at the time of the nomination. Nominee must also remain a member in good standing to receive recognition at the time the Code of Ethics Leadership Award is presented at the 2012 Circle of Excellence Banquet.
3. Nominee must have previously participated in local, state, and/or national association grievance, professional standards, arbitration, or ethics related activities.
4. The deadline for submitting nominations to ACAR is Monday, February 6, 2012.
5. The awards committee will select the Code of Ethics Leadership Award recipient from submitted nominations. Recipient will be announced at the Circle of Excellence Banquet on Saturday, March 10, 2012.

I. BUSINESS AND EDUCATIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Business history of the candidate since entering the real estate business, including designations earned. Describe the candidates standing in the community as a REALTOR® and list specific contributions to the community through real estate. You may include business reputation with other REALTORS®, imaginative and creative marketing concepts, and clientele testimonials.

II. LOCAL/STATE and/or NATIONAL ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES
